1914

Ernest Emmanuel Howard, the "H" in HNTB, establishes the partnership of Harrington, Howard & Ash, later to become HNTB.

1954

HNTB opens an office in Boston to provide services for the Massachusetts Turnpike Authority.

1978

HNTB completes design of the \$270M design and construction services of the 2.2-mile Orange Line Southwest Corridor rail extension in Boston. It was the largest single construction contract in the City's history.

2003

HNTB was awarded an AISC Grand Conceptor and ASCE OPAL Award for the design of the Zakim River Bridge. The widest cable stayed structure in the world, this span serves as a Boston landmark.

2012

HNTB begins work on MassDOT's South Station Expansion and MBTA's Green Line Extension, two of the most high-profile rail projects in the state.

2013

HNTB celebrates groundbreaking ceremony for MassDOT's Whittier Bridge/I-95 Improvement. This \$292 million design-build bridge replacement will be the first interstate highway bridge in Massachusetts to accommodate pedestrians and cyclists.
