



WTS Junior College/Trade School Scholarship

WTS fosters the development of women in the transportation field by encouraging bright new professionals to undertake careers in the area of transportation. One way it does this is by awarding community, technical, or trade college scholarships to women pursuing transportation- related study at community and trade colleges.

This scholarship is intended for students pursuing an associate or technical degree in transportation-related studies.

The WTS Junior College/Trade School Scholarship is awarded at the local and international level. The WTS Sacramento Chapter will award is \$2,000 to the local recipient. The application of the local recipient is forwarded for entrance in the international scholarship selection process. The international award is in the amount of \$1,000. The minimum criteria for selection are:

- a. GPA of 3.0 or higher
- b. Currently enrolled in a degree program in a transportation-related field.
- c. Plans to pursue a career in a transportation-related field.

Applications must be submitted through local WTS chapters as a typed **PDF**. Scholarships are competitive and based on the applicant's specific transportation goals, academic record, and transportation-related activities or job skills. National awards will be presented during the WTS Annual Conference on May 16, 2019, and attendance at the awards dinner is strongly recommended. **The scholarship recipient will receive \$2,000 at our WTS Annual Awards and Scholarship dinner on January 30, 2019.**
