The scholarship is named for the former Director of the California Department of Transportation who serves as a strong advocate for WTS and the importance of education.

Criteria for the Scholarship:

- a. **Female high school senior, graduating in Spring of 2010**
- b. **GPA of 3.0 or higher**
- c. **Attending college after high school graduation**
- d. **Pursuing a career in a transportation-related field**

The **WTS-Sacramento Chapter Will Kempton High School Scholarship** is competitive and will be awarded based on the applicant's academic achievements, extra-curricular activities and commitments, personal written statement, and a letter of recommendation. **The scholarship recipient will receive \$500 at our WTS Annual Awards and Scholarship dinner on Wednesday, December 9, 2009.**
