PROGRAM INFORMATION

The 2019 conference will be held June 2 - 6, 2019, in Washington, D.C.

ELIGIBILITY

All applicants must:

1. Be a WTS member in good standing. **Please verify membership before submitting any application materials by emailing membership@wtsinternational.org.**
2. Be pursuing a master's or doctoral degree in a transportation-related discipline **OR** have obtained a master's or doctoral degree in a transportation-related discipline within the past five years and be working in the field.

APPLICATION - Must be submitted by Monday February 25, 2019"

All applications must include the following six parts and be contained in a **single .pdf** document. The application consists **ONLY** of the items listed below.

1. A cover letter with all contact information.
2. A resume (Two-page maximum).
3. A one-page letter of interest. The letter should provide reasons for wanting to participate in this conference and explain how the experience will benefit your professional goals.
4. Two letters of recommendation, preferably one from a supervisor and one from a professor. All letters must be signed and dated within one year of applying. If a letter from a professor is not obtainable, submit two letters from senior company management, one being a current supervisor. The letters should detail your qualifications for this program.
5. Evidence of a degree, with date received.
6. Evidence of your current grade point average, or if you have graduated, your grade point average at the time of graduation.

The WTS selection committee will review all applications and the successful applicant will be notified by phone no later than March 11, 2019.

All other applicants will receive notice by email.
