

State of the Streets



Increases in Roadway Infrastructure Since 2008

- Streets (Lane Miles) = 165%
- Sidewalk (Miles) = 248%
- Irrigated Landscape (Acres) = 353%
- Landscape Area (Acres) = 231%
- Traffic Signals = 266%


