

WTS Molitoris Leadership Scholarship for Undergraduates

The WTS Molitoris Leadership Fund for Undergraduates is awarded to a woman who demonstrates leadership in the transportation industry. Applicants must be currently enrolled in a full-time **undergraduate degree program** in transportation and must specifically address the issue of leadership on their personal statement.

The WTS Metropolitan Phoenix Chapter awards **\$2,000** to the winner of the Molitoris Leadership Fund. The scholarship application is then forwarded to the WTS International Foundation to compete for the International award, an additional **\$5,000**. The minimum criteria for selection are:

- a. GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- b. Currently enrolled in an undergraduate degree program in a transportation-related field, such as transportation engineering, planning, finance, or logistics.
- c. Plans to pursue a career in a transportation-related field.
- d. Applicants for the Molitoris Leadership Scholarship must specifically address the issue of leadership on their personal statement.

Applications must be submitted through WTS Metropolitan Phoenix as typed documents. Scholarships are competitive and based on the applicant's specific transportation goals, academic record, and transportation-related activities or job skills. Local scholarship winners are strongly encouraged to attend the local awards ceremony, date TBA. National awards will be presented during the WTS Annual Conference in May 2021, and attendance during the awards ceremony is strongly recommended.
