

WTS Helene M. Overly/Esther Kmetty Memorial Scholarship

The WTS Metropolitan Phoenix Helene M. Overly/Esther Kmetty Memorial Scholarship is awarded to a woman pursuing **graduate studies** in transportation who demonstrates a strong commitment to the community.

The WTS Metropolitan Phoenix Chapter awards \$3,000 to the winner of the Overly/Kmetty Scholarship. The scholarship application is then forwarded to the WTS International Foundation to compete for the International award, an additional \$10,000. The minimum criteria for selection are:

- a. GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- b. Currently enrolled in a graduate degree program in a transportation-related field, such as transportation engineering, planning, finance, or logistics.
- c. Plans to pursue a career in a transportation-related field.

Applications must be submitted through WTS Metropolitan Phoenix as typed documents. Scholarships are competitive and based on the applicant's specific transportation goals, academic record, and transportation-related activities or job skills. Local scholarship winners are strongly encouraged to attend the local awards ceremony, date TBA. National awards will be presented during the WTS Annual Conference in May 2021, and attendance during the awards ceremony is strongly recommended.
