



Support Sky Harbor Coalition Scholarship for Undergraduate and Graduate Students

In partnership with WTS, the Support Sky Harbor Coalition Graduate Scholarship is awarded to a woman, or women, pursuing undergraduate or graduate studies in aviation or an aviation-related field. Recognizing that large airports like Sky Harbor are very complex in nature and require multiple professional disciplines to effectively plan, build and operate, studies could include, but are not limited to: public administration, architecture, engineering, transportation management, logistics, etc.

This scholarship is in the amount of up to \$5,000 and is offered on the local level only. The minimum criteria for selection are as follows:

- a. Open to women.
- b. GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- c. Currently enrolled in a full-time undergraduate or graduate degree program in an aviation-related field.
- d. Plans to pursue a career in the aviation industry.
- e. Must demonstrate strong leadership skills and campus and community involvement.

Applications must be submitted through WTS Metropolitan Phoenix as typed documents. Scholarships are competitive and based on the applicant's specific transportation goals, academic record, and aviation-related activities or job skills. Local scholarship winners are strongly encouraged to attend the local awards ceremony, date TBA.
