Nominations will be voted on by the WTS-GNY Recognitions Committee and the awards will be announced during the Annual Meeting in early 2021.



YP Watch Party: The Neuroscience of Decision-Making: Are We Foul or Fair?

On November 17, the WTS Young Professionals had the opportunity to join Kimberly Papillon, a nationally recognized expert on the subject of decision-making in law, education, business and medicine, for a Watch-Party and Q&A Session. After watching Ms. Papillon's Ted Talk, The Neuroscience of Decision-Making: Are We Foul or Fair, our participants discussed common situations that we might face at work, and methods for reaching the goal of impartial decision-making. Ms. Papillon referenced neurophysiologic studies during the discussion for participants to better understand what keeps us from effectively solving problems, what motivates us, scares us and fools us. The biggest message Ms. Papillon imparted is that fair decision making is rooted in accurate decision making. If we process all the facts devoid of internal influences and bias, we increase the likelihood of making an accurate and fair decision.
