The 2020 WTS-GNY Annual Meeting, held on January 22 at Manhattan Manor, was an evening of new beginnings and a changing

of the guard. It provided an opportunity to honor individuals and employers, who have made a myriad of contributions to the chapter and strides in advancing women in transportation, as well as to highlight innovative projects. The event attracted over 250 industry professionals from over 60 organizations and four public agencies. Fredericka Cuenca, deputy chief development officer-Planning at MTA Construction & Development, served as keynote speaker.

The inaugural meeting of each year also features the W/M/S/DBE Expo, which WTS-GNY proudly holds to give member firms a chance to showcase their specialties and services. Malick & Scherer, P.C., Yu & Associates, B. Thayer Associates (BTA), were among the DBEs established in the 1990's which had tables. Representatives from GMA Engineering, which was established in 2019, were also on hand at the Expo to discuss their company. Though the evening was cold, the room was filled with the warm familiar faces of the WTS-GNY community.

Outgoing president, Alexa Gangemi, began the main program by noting that 2020 marks WTS-GNY's 40th anniversary. The chapter was the fifth to be established nationwide. Out of the 79 chapters, Greater New York is the largest with over 420 members. Throughout the year, WTS-GNY will be commemorating its many milestones. Gangemi then turned over the chapter's reins to new President Keri Cibelli, who seconded Gangemi's sentiments. Cibelli recognized several founding members in the audience: Maxine Finkelstein, the chapter's first president, Deborah Wathen Finn and Susan Gilbert.

Aside from the 40th anniversary, 2020 will see the creation of the New Jersey Chapter. WTS-GNY will support its sister organization through its launch and collaborate on efforts aimed at the advancement of women in the New York metropolitan area. Cibelli thanked the outgoing board for its hard work and outlined the bold agenda that she and her new board have planned. She also expressed gratitude to her colleagues at AKRF and its female CEO for supporting women through leadership and diversity initiatives.


