

Pioneering Port Leader Feted for Feats

Since she sailed into the Port of Los Angeles in 2006, Dr. Geraldine Knatz has rocked the boat with industry, changing environmental initiatives that lowered diesel emissions roughly 80 percent, navigating the port into a record-high capital development era to expand and modernize cargo facilities, and initiating the development of a world-class public waterfront.

On December 5, 2014, WTS Los Angeles honored trailblazing Port of Los Angeles executive director with a special reception at the port to acknowledge her outstanding accomplishments and her retirement.
