For students, the Transportation Résumé Book offers an opportunity to place their résumé before potential employment opportunities. For WTS-LA corporate partners, the résumé book offers descriptions of potential employees who can grow into future transportation leaders. The 2015 Transportation Résumé Book received a record high number of resumes from over 100 graduating students spanning 10 universities. The resume book is composed of 5 categories including engineering, planning, environmental, public policy, and logistics. The book was published to all corporate sponsors on May 8.

Marking the book's eighth year, this year's Transportation Résumé Book mixer made its debut and was held at Caltrans District 7 headquarters on April 30, 2015. Attendees included students participating in the résumé book and other students interested in WTS.

"Networking is a skill that's not necessarily taught in school," noted Todd Nguyen (above), chapter board member and the mixer's organizer. "Having gone through the recruitment process myself, I want to help students sharpen their networking skills; it is a skill that students have to build.
