## **2021-2022 WTS-SAR High School Scholarship Application**

The San Antonio Region (SAR) Chapter of the Women's Transportation Seminar (WTS) is pleased to announce its scholarship program for high school senior girls. WTS is an international organization of transportation professionals who are committed to career and industry excellence. WTS fosters the development of women and girls in the transportation field by encouraging bright new professionals and students to undertake careers in the area of transportation. One way it does this is by awarding scholarships to girls pursuing high school studies in science, technology, engineering and math.

**WTS-SAR will award one scholarship in the amount of \$1,000 to an outstanding high school senior student for the 2021 – 2022 school year.** All applicants may also be considered for the WTS International Transportation YOU High School Scholarship in the amount of \$1,000. Transportation YOU is a hands-on, interactive, mentoring program that offers young girls ages 13-18 an introduction to a wide variety of transportation careers. Through the mentoring and scholarship programs, the SAR Chapter works to make a difference in the lives of young girls by offering programs and activities that will spark their interest in all modes of transportation and encourage them to take courses in math, science, and technology, which are the stepping stones to exciting careers that can change the face of the transportation industry. Your completed application must include: (1) this **signed Application** Form, (2) electronic Application Form in a **typed Word document**, (3) a current official transcript from the school currently enrolled, (4) an official letter of reference from an academic adviser, instructor, or workplace superior, and (5) your personal statement. If you have a resume noting employment or volunteer activities and other training, please also include with your signed application. The minimum criteria for selection are as follows:

- a. Open to high school senior girls who attend school in South, South Central or West Texas.
- b. Currently enrolled in a high school studying math, science, and technology,
- c. GPA of 3.0 or higher,
- d. Considering a career in a transportation-related field.
