Crystal Daughtry, The Pittsburgh Institute of Aeronautics

Recipient of the 2021 WTS Pittsburgh Chapter Sharon D. Banks Memorial Undergraduate Scholarship is Crystal Daughtry, who will be receiving a degree from The Pittsburgh Institute of Aeronautics in June, 2021. Crystal began her education journey at Eastern University. After graduating with a Bachelor of Arts in Anthropology, she began her professional career in the transportation field with Delta Air Lines in 2011.



Crystal's time with Delta had been quite rewarding with many opportunities to witness the innovative ways aviation has enhanced transportation over the years. She spent two years working at the LaGuardia Airport in New York City, where she watched a

massive growth in Delta Airlines as they expanded their services. Though this was a time of maturation, Crystal had a desire to do more within the company. She began to pursue a new career in becoming an aircraft mechanic and to accomplish that goal, a move back to Pittsburgh was required. Upon her return to Pittsburgh, she began taking courses at the Community College of Allegheny County to gain a basic understanding of mechanical concepts. Her time there was completed with an Associate of Science in Mechatronics, which truly created a great foundation for the final step in becoming a certified aviation mechanic. In the fall of 2019 she began studying at The Pittsburgh Institute of Aeronautics to obtain an Associate's degree in Specialized Aviation Technology and an Airframe and Powerplant Certificate.
