

WTS International is an international organization with over 6,000 members dedicated to the professional advancement of women in transportation careers. WTS chapters work to make a difference in the lives of girls by offering programs and activities that will spark their interest in all modes of transportation and encourage them to take courses in math, science, and technology, which are the stepping stones to exciting careers that can change the face of the transportation industry. Awarding scholarships to girls pursuing school studies in science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM) is one way that WTS International encourages future interest in transportation-related professions.

The WTS Western North Carolina Chapter will be offering **three** STEM Camp Scholarships for the summer of 2021, in an amount not to exceed \$250 each, to be paid directly to the STEM-based camp of your choice. Transportation to the camp will be the responsibility of the awarded scholar.

The minimum criteria for selection are as follows:

- A. Open to girls ages 10-17.
- B. Residing in western North Carolina (areas included in Regional Council regions A, B, C, D or E see map at http://www.ncregions.org/regional-councils/; counties including Alleghany, Alexander, Ashe, Avery, Buncombe, Burke, Caldwell, Catawba, Cherokee, Clay, Cleveland, Graham, Haywood, Henderson, Jackson, Macon, Madison, McDowell, Mitchell, Polk, Rutherford, Transylvania, Swain, Watauga, Wilkes and Yancey)
- C. GPA of 2.5 or higher (or demonstration of equivalent school performance).
- D. Interested in learning more about the natural world, math, science, or transportation-related studies.
- E. A letter of recommendation from a transportation, science, engineering, math, or technology teacher or professional.

Applications must be submitted through WTS Western NC chapter. This scholarship is competitive and based on the applicant's specific goals, academic record and science and transportation-related activities and interests. Minority candidates are encouraged to apply.

Please return the completed application electronically to wtm.com (put "summer camp scholarship" in the subject line) by the end of business day on Friday April 16, 2021.



Applications may also be mailed to WTS WNC Chapter, PO Box 743, Asheville, NC 28802. Electronic submissions are preferred.

The award will be announced by Friday April 30, 2021.

One applicant will be selected and notified, and a scholarship check from WTS Western NC will be made out to the camp of the selected applicant's choice. Please indicate the camp's name and mailing information for payment. Please note that the family of the student will be responsible for paying the remaining balance if camp costs exceed \$250.

Summer camp programs targeted for this application are expected to contribute to learning about the natural world and the environment, math, science or engineering and transportation studies in some ways. Summer camp locations are not limited to western North Carolina. Due to COVID restrictions, some camps may be canceled or have limited space. It is up to the camper's family to secure a spot at the camp of choice. Examples of eligible summer camp programs include but are not limited to:
