

South Carolina Transportation News Highlight

The Lowcountry Rapid Transit (LCRT) project is a bus rapid transit system designed to connect North Charleston to Downtown Charleston sponsored by the Berkeley-Charleston-Dorchester Council of Governments. The LCRT would be the state's first bus rapid transit system. Buses would arrive at stops approximately every 10 minutes throughout most of the day, operate primarily in dedicated lanes, and offer a high-quality, reliable transit system. Frequent service, faster trips, and fewer stops are just a few of the key benefits of the LCRT project. Find out more.
