## **BUILDING BRIDGES AT GIRL DAY 2020**

About 600 students designed, created, and built bridges using toothpicks and marshmallows, and then load tested them with candy "cars" during Girl Day at UT. WTS Transportation YOU was among 162 organizations sponsoring activities in the STEM fields.
