### **Transportation in the News** South Carolina Transportation News Highlight

SCDOT is conducting a Planning & Environmental Linkages (PEL) Study for the I-526 Lowcountry Corridor EAST (I-526 LCC EAST), which extends along I-526 from Virginia Avenue in North Charleston to approximately US 17 in Mount Pleasant. This is the first PEL to be completed in South Carolina and will be used to establish a vision for the corridor that will guide future transportation improvement projects. Currently, a Public Information Meeting is underway to explain how public input has been used to inform the concepts development and screening process, ask for input on the Reasonable Alternatives, and outline the next steps as the results of the PEL are carried forward into the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) process.
