Mentorship with WTS Toronto

The WTS Toronto Area Chapter enlists the support of senior-level individuals who are willing to share their professional experiences with others. We also seek mid-level professionals who are interested in advancing their career and enhancing their professional profile and skills.

Through an application process, the mentors and mentees are matched based on a combination of their mutual professional interests. With assistance from the Chapter, mentor-mentee teams develop a series of goals and objectives to achieve during the course of the 12-month Mentorship Program.

The WTS Toronto Area Chapter Mentorship Program provides a forum for people interested in developing the skills necessary to achieve professional success and personal goals. The program also offers support from experienced mentors, peer networking and candid conversations with successful transportation leaders.

Mentor-mentee teams meet, face-to-face or virtually, on a regular basis to work towards their goals and objectives. Teams will attend "group sessions" where the mentor and mentee can interact with other teams, participate in group learning and development, meet the WTS Board of Directors, share experiences and provide feedback in an informal setting. Mentor-mentee teams provide formal feedback on their progress via survey at the mid-way point and prior to program close.
