

The Glass Ceiling Committee is Kicking Off its 2020 Work Plan

In 2017, WTS-GNY sent a survey to government entities, public and private corporations, as well as non-profit organizations in the New York and New Jersey Metropolitan area. In 2019, WTS-GNY published our first Glass Ceiling Report.

In 2020, the committee will issue a follow-up survey to examine trends and progress in the industry. In addition, we will be pursuing a number of smaller-scale momentum and awareness-building projects aimed at equipping our members with resources and information to address glass ceiling challenges.
