Transportation YOU Summer Internship at MTA New York City Transit

Committee has established a dynamic program that offers City Poly Technic
High School students unique exposure to the transportation profession through behind- the-scenes tours and events. The 2014-2015 program

included tours of Mother Clara Hale Bus Depot and JFK Airport, as well as a professional development workshop focused on effective communications. This year also featured a new S.T.E.M. summer internship and College Buddy in partnership with City Polytechnic HS and MTA New York City Transit.

Over the course of six weeks, 10 students completed detailed projects for various NYCT departments. The internship gave them the opportunity to get hands-on experience working in the transportation industry. NYCT Human Resources provided



additional support by matching the students with college buddies interning in the agency's Student Experiential Program. At the end of the internship, the girls gave presentations on the results of their six weeks of hard work as they shared comprehensive maps, detailed plans and designs to a room full of NYCT managers.

Campbell was previously the director of financial management systems at Los Angeles World Airports for the City of Los Angeles. Prior to that position, Campbell had






