

WTS Community College/Technical/Trade Degree Scholarship

WTS fosters the development of women in the transportation field by encouraging bright new professionals to undertake careers in transportation. One way it does this is by awarding community, technical, or trade college scholarships to women pursuing transportation- related careers.

This scholarship is intended for students pursuing an Associate's Degree, Bachelor's of Technology Degree, or other technical degree in transportation-related studies.

The Community College/Technical/Trade Degree Scholarship is **\$2,500**. The recipient of this scholarship will also advance to the national competition for a chance of being awarded **\$2,500**. The requirements for this scholarship application are:

- a. GPA of 3.0 or higher, Official copy of transcript
- b. Currently enrolled in a degree program in a transportation-related field, such as, but not limited to, civil engineering, construction management, transportation engineering or planning, aviation, transit, rail, business management, finance, or logistics with a focus on public policy, and/or interest in advocacy for transportation.
- c. Plans to pursue a career in a transportation-related field.
- d. Recommendation Survey (see section IV)
- e. Personal Statement
- f. Proof of Enrollment

Scholarships are competitive and based on the applicant's specific transportation goals, academic record, and transportation-related activities or job skills. Greater New York scholarships will be presented at a reception in the fall of 2022, and recipient's attendance is encouraged. National awards will be presented in the spring of 2023.
