



## **WTS Paula Hammond Leadership Legacy Scholarship**

WTS launched the Leadership Legacy Scholarship in 2007. This scholarship is awarded to an outstanding young woman pursuing graduate studies working toward a career in transportation or a related field, and who demonstrates a specific interest in advancing transportation innovation in the international arena. The WTS Paula Hammond Leadership Legacy Scholarship is **\$3,000**. The recipient of this scholarship will also advance to the national competition for a chance of being awarded **\$5,000**.

The WTS mission is to build the transportation industry through the global advancement of women by encouraging women to further their careers as leaders in transportation. WTS recognizes that transportation is more than simply moving people and goods from one place to another. It is a driver of growth and an integral part of communities throughout the world. The leadership, skills, and perspectives of women are essential to ensure that the transportation systems of the future respond to the needs of all. Through the Leadership Legacy Scholarship, WTS seeks to motivate and reward women who demonstrate leadership in the industry to bring ideas, innovation, and new approaches to transportation challenges in the US and beyond.

The Leadership Legacy Scholarship currently takes the name of the 2020-2022 WTS International Chair, Paula Hammond. It has a sustainable community and public transit focus with emphasis on candidates who are working to rejoin the workforce after some time away from the industry.

The requirements for this scholarship application are:

- a. GPA of 3.0 or higher, Proof of transcript
- b. Currently enrolled in a graduate degree program in a transportation-related field, such as transportation planning or engineering, security planning, business management, finance, or logistics with a focus on public policy.
- c. Plans to pursue a career in a transportation-related field.
- d. Demonstrated interest in addressing transportation studies issue(s).
- e. Two (2) Recommendation Surveys (see section IV)
- f. Personal Statement
- g. Proof of Enrollment

Scholarships are competitive and based on the applicant's specific transportation goals, academic record, and transportation-related activities or job skills. Greater New York scholarships will be presented at a reception in the fall of 2022, and recipient's attendance is encouraged. National awards will be presented in the spring of 2023.
