




If approved by voters

• Extends the half-cent sales tax an additional 10 years

Current sales tax rate will remain the same

• Generates approximately \$740 million in revenue

All funds would be used for transportation



80% to neighborhood streets 20% to street safety projects



Neighborhood Street Improvement Plan

- Improve EVERY neighborhood street owned and maintained by the City
- All neighborhood streets will undergo an engineering analysis to determine treatment type





Street Safety Projects

- Sidewalk and Pedestrian Accessibility
- Bicycle Network Enhancements
- Systemwide Safety Improvements
- Traffic Signal Technology Upgrades





Oversight and Accountability – two citizens' commissions

- Independent Oversight and Accountability Commission
- Complete Streets Coordinating Council
- Commissions will select and prioritize projects
- Commission will ensure funds are spent as directed by voters
- Technical assistance from DTM staff
- This is a model used by the City for Props 409, 101, and 407



Proposition 411 and Regional Plans

- Compliments a regional strategy today and in the future
- RTA focuses on regionwide mobility and safety and transportation mode choices
- Prop 411 invests in neighborhood street maintenance
- City is looking forward to working with regional partners to craft RTA Next Plan
- We understand the importance of the RTA for the success and prosperity of our region
