### WTS Toronto Area Indigenous Student Scholarship

The Indigenous undergraduate student scholarship is open to any enrolled post-secondary school students with indigenous heritage who are pursuing a degree in planning, economics, engineering, political science, environmental science, and other programs that will lead to a career focused on transportation. Students are eligible if they are currently attending an institution within Canada.

Two \$3,000 (CAD) scholarships will be awarded to the successful applicants. Awards may be granted to graduate students in the event that there are no qualified undergraduate student candidates.

Selection of the recipients will be made in October 2022, with a presentation of the scholarships in late October 2022 at the Annual Event. Should no qualified candidates apply by the closing date shown below, applications will remain open. Each recipient's name and photo will also appear in WTS publications. The successful student(s) will also receive an invitation to attend the WTS Toronto Chapter Annual Event in late October 2022 with some expenses covered by WTS.

#### 2. Letter of Recommendation: (Max. 1 page)

Attach one (1) letter of recommendation from a previous teacher, professor, employer, or community leader (including Elder, mentor, or cultural teacher). The letter should address why you are a good candidate based on the noted scholarship criteria.

#### 3. Proof of Enrollment:

Attach a copy of your tuition receipt or registration receipt.

#### 4. Transcripts:

Attach a copy of your most recent transcript. If first year attach high school transcript.

#### 5. Proof of Ancestry:

Provide proof of ancestry in one of several following formats: Indian status card, Métis Nation citizenship card, Inuit Trust Card or a letter from band or community representative, affidavit stating the reason why such documents cannot be attained.
