

DBE Diversity and Inclusion Committee Hosts Recruiting and Retention Roundtable



WTS Atlanta is excited to be ramping up our effort to help our DBE sponsors and members in 2022. Our goals are to help connect DBE's to discuss issues pertinent to these firms, disseminate relevant agency information and advice, provide greater networking events, as well as to provide opportunities that will expand the DBE firms access to larger consulting firms to help maximize teaming arrangements. The committee holds quarterly roundtable meetings where special guests are invited to lead discussions on wide ranging topics that are relevant to our DBE partners. Our first roundtable set the agenda for big issues our group wanted to explore and tackle.

Our second roundtable special guest was Hive Talent Acquisition Firm (DBE) who led a lively and interactive session with the attendees related to recruiting and retention techniques. he committee is also planning networking events including a joint WTS Atlanta and COMTO Atlanta DBE Matchmaking event scheduled for early fall. This is the 3rd or 4th WTS/COMTO DBE Matchmaking event we participated in. Up to now, the DBE matching held October 5, 2021, was the first time that we spoke to primes who brought the right representative (versus the prime's DBE or DE&I representative) who has the authority to make a commitment and understands how to leverage the capabilities for a given prime.
