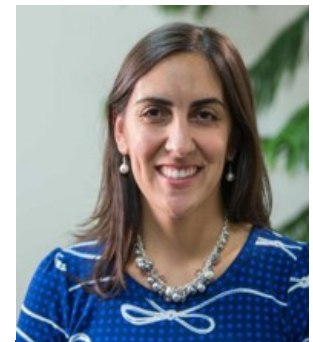
At the 2022 Annual Meeting, our chapter extended honorary membership to Valeriya Remezova and Jennifer Marandino. Please join us in welcoming them!
