

# Women's Transportation Seminar (WTS) Philadelphia Chapter Suzanne Axworthy Undergraduate Scholarship

WTS Philadelphia fosters the development of women in the transportation field by encouraging bright new professionals to undertake careers in the area of transportation. One way it does this is by awarding the Suzanne Axworthy Scholarship to women currently pursuing undergraduate studies in transportation-related field.

For over 25 years, Suzanne developed and advocated for public and specialized transportation throughout Philadelphia, working for SEPTA, WHEELS, Inc., and as a consultant. She was an active member of WTS Philadelphia for as long as she was a transportation professional, serving as its Awards Chair from 1986-91, Vice President from 1989-91, and President from 1991- 93. Suzanne will be remembered for her professionalism, grace, and style, and for the warm and enthusiastic encouragement, she gave to many WTS members. In 2001, the Philadelphia Chapter proudly announced the undergraduate scholarship in her name as a memorial to her years of dedicated service.

The minimum criteria for selection are as follows:

- a) Minimum 3.0 GPA
- b) Currently enrolled in an undergraduate degree program in a transportation-related field, such as transportation engineering, planning, finance, or logistics.
- c) Plans to pursue a career in a transportation-related field

The scholarships are competitive and based on the applicant's specific transportation involvement, goals, job skills, and academic record. WTS Philadelphia is committed to the inclusion of differences and similarities related to ethnicity, age, and gender identity. Local recipients will be announced in November 2023. The final decision for all scholarship awards is solely within the discretion of the WTS Philadelphia Scholarship Committee.

Local Philadelphia Chapter winners for each scholarship may advance to the opportunity to win the WTS International Foundation's national scholarship award. WTS Suzanne Axworthy Undergraduate Scholarship winners will be entered to compete for the WTS International Sharon D. Banks Memorial Undergraduate Scholarship or the WTS International Molitoris Leadership Scholarship for Undergraduates.

All materials must be typed and submitted in electronic format (submission of a single .pdf is preferred). Except for the letter of recommendation, all materials must arrive in a single email with the subject line "WTS UG Scholarship - <insert your last name>. All materials must be received by **11:59 pm EST on Friday, November 3, 2023.** All submission materials and questions should be directed to:

Applicants must address the issue of leadership, its importance in a transportation career, and the applicant's leadership achievements. The statement should not exceed 500 words.
- VI. **Proof of Enrollment:** Include a copy of your tuition receipt or current registration card.
- VII. **Transcript:** Include an official copy of the transcript of your most recent year of study to this application that includes your current semester course load. Freshmen undergraduates may submit a high school transcript. Digital transcripts must bear a digital verification and/or be signed and dated by a counselor, professor, or program coordinator. Applicants must also include a current semester course load, if not already listed in transcripts.
- VIII. **Applicant's Biography:** Include a one (1) paragraph statement describing the applicant's background, schooling, the focus of the degree, academic accomplishments, and interest in the transportation industry. (Note, if selected for a scholarship, this paragraph will be utilized in the event program.)
