



Friends of Transit Scholarship

In partnership with WTS, the Friends of Transit Scholarship is awarded to an applicant (man or woman) pursuing undergraduate or graduate studies in a full-time degree program in public transit or a transportation-related field with plans to pursue a career in the transportation industry. Recognizing that public transit and transportation systems are complex in nature and require multiple professional disciplines to effectively plan, build and operate, studies could include, but are not limited to: public administration, architecture, engineering, construction, transportation management, logistics, sustainability, etc. Applicants must be able to demonstrate strong leadership skills along with campus and community involvement.

This scholarship is in the amount of **\$2,500** and is offered at the local level only. The minimum criteria for selection are as follows:

- a. Open to women or men, undergraduate or graduate students.
- b. GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- c. Currently enrolled in a full-time undergraduate or graduate degree program in one of the aforementioned fields.
- d. Plans to pursue a career in the transit industry.

Applications must be submitted through WTS Metropolitan Phoenix as typed documents. Scholarships are competitive and based on the applicant's specific transportation goals, academic record, and transportation-related activities or job skills. Local scholarship winners are strongly encouraged to attend the local awards ceremony, March 30, 2024. Awards banquet seats for scholarship winners are complimentary.
