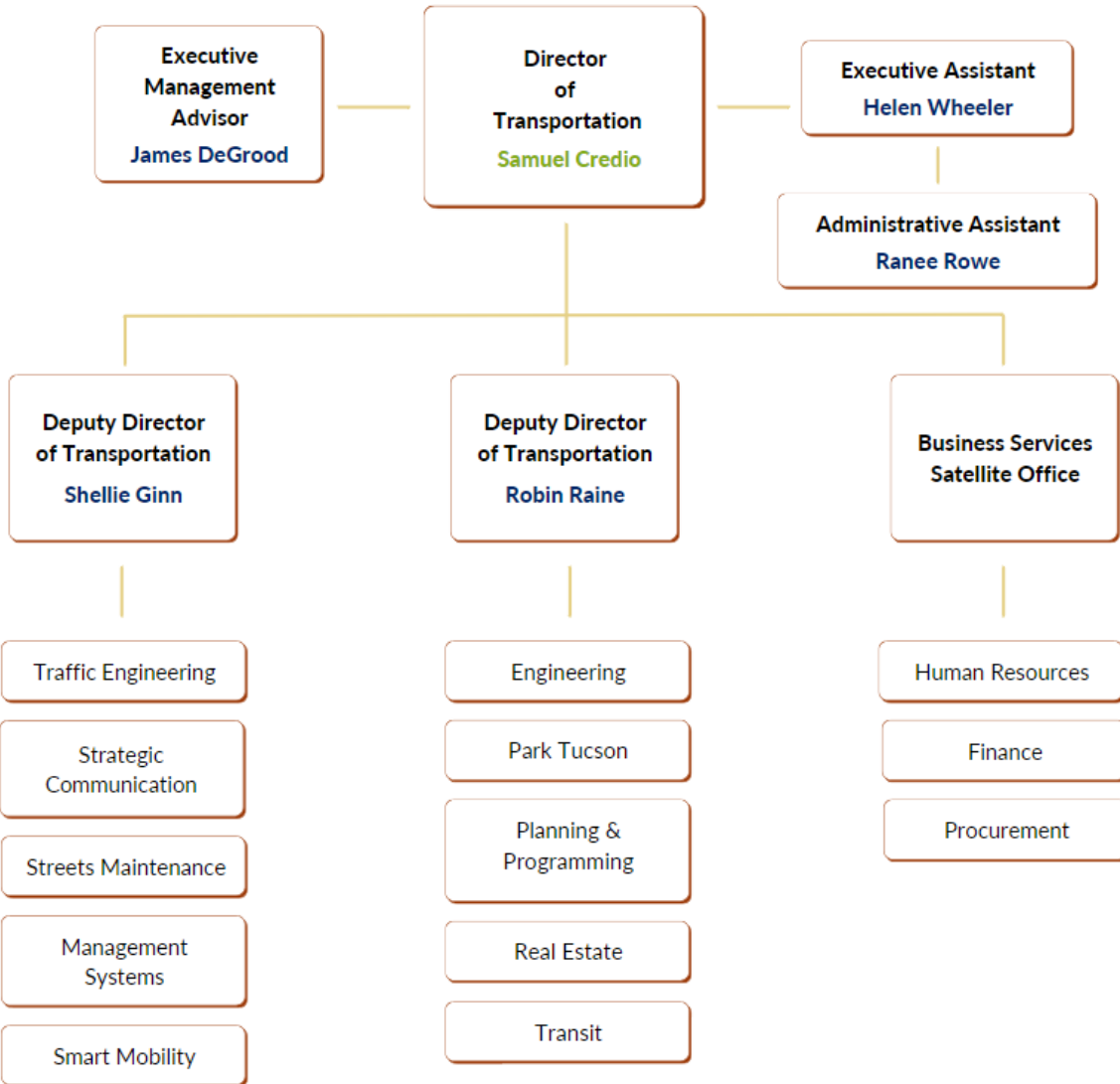

PROPOSITION 411

TUCSON DELIVERS – BETTER STREETS



May 2022

- Prop 411 Passed
- 73% voted 'Yes'

July 2022

- Sales tax collections begin
- Nearly \$101 million collected in first 16-months

February 2023

- Initial Project List Approved
- Over 3 Million Sq. Yd. of neighborhood resurfacing

May 2023

- Construction begins on Initial Projects

TODAY

- Initial project construction continues & working to identify Phase I project sequencing
- Utility coordination and treatment type

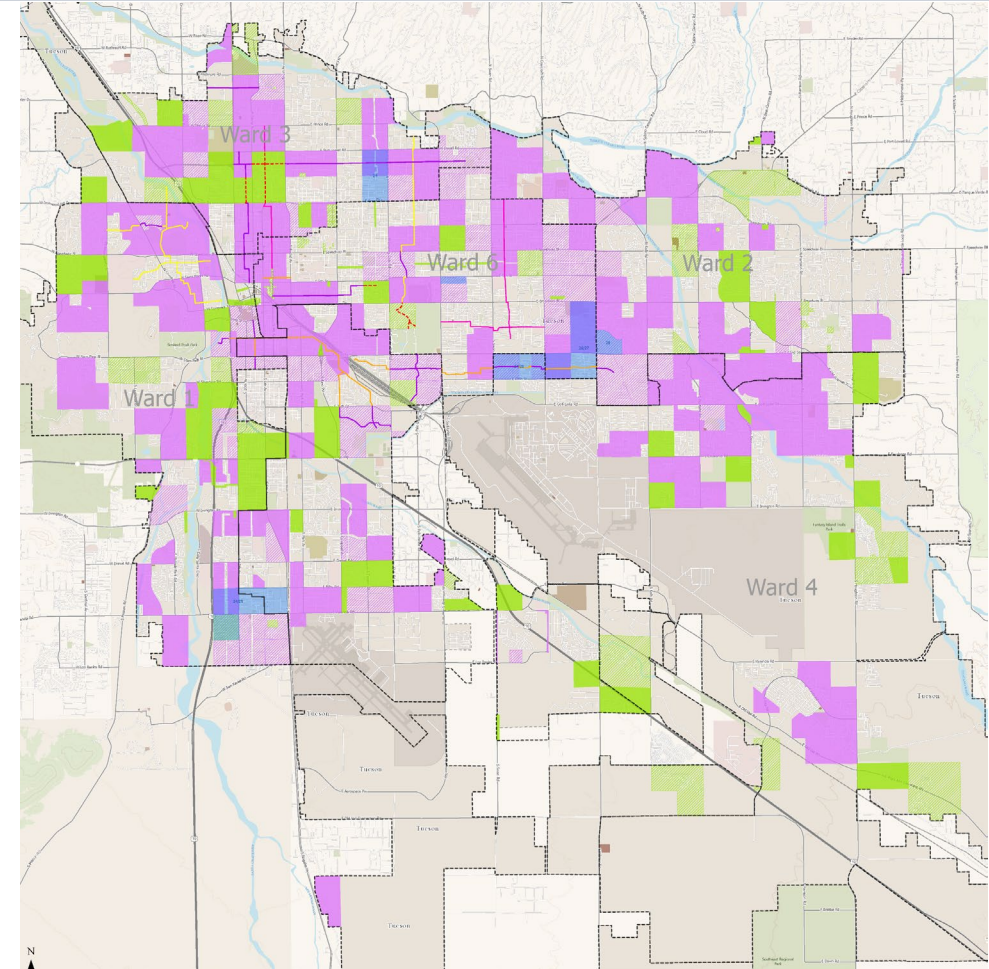
June 2023

- Phase I projects approved (2024-2026)



INDEPENDENT OVERSIGHT & ACCOUNTABILITY COMMISSION (IOAC)

- ▶ 10-member appointed citizens' oversight commission
 - Former BOC members oversaw Prop 101
- ▶ Select and prioritize roadway project phasing
 - With DTM recommendations
- ▶ Monitor funds and progress of projects



2023 COMPLETED PROJECTS

Over 985,000 square yards of roads resurfaced in 15 neighborhoods

UPCOMING PROJECTS

Over 1,890,000 square yards of roads in 23 neighborhoods are under contract so far this year.

- **Surface Treatments** – Harlan Heights, Mitman/Thunderbird, Wilshire Heights, Monte Catalina Estates
- **Paving** – Rodeo Addition, Julia Keen, Halcyon Acres/Hermosa Hills, Coronado Heights, Barrio Nopal/Elvira, Sunset Villa, Flowing Wells (Westwood), Garden District (Speedway Addition), Doolen-Fruitvale, Sewell, Barrio Kroeger Lane, Escalante Road
- **Collector Streets** – Starr Pass/Players Club

Nearly 500,000 square yards of roads in 14 neighborhoods in development.

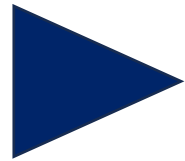

Coronado Heights Neighborhood

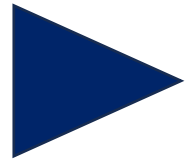

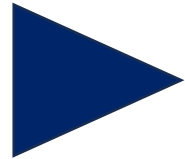

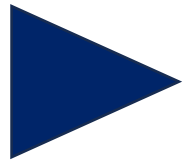

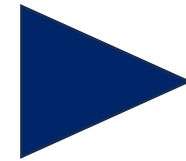

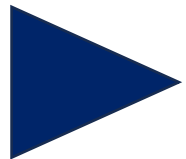
Grant Road at I-10/UPRR

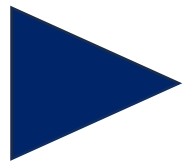

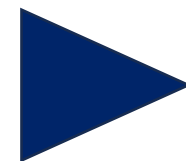
