

U.S. DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION



The United States Department of Transportation (USDOT) is headquartered in the Navy Yard area of Washington, D.C. The Secretary of Transportation, Pete Buttigieg, famously lives near HQ, and often bikes to the office. The USDOT is composed of multiple Administrations: Transit, Highways, Maritime, Aviation, Motor Carrier, Railroad, and Highway Safety. Amtrak is the National Railroad Passenger
Corporation, which operates about 300
passenger trains across the United States and
Canada daily. Amtrak is headquartered at the

TURNER-FAIRBANK RESEARCH CENTER



The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA)
Office of Research, Development, and
Technology (RD&T) is located at the TurnerFairbank Highway Research Center (TFHRC) in
McLean, VA. The center houses 15 laboratories
and support facilities. TFHRC conducts advanced
research in vehicle-highway interaction, safety,
pavements, highway structures and bridges,
human-centered systems, operations and
intelligent transportation systems, and materials.
During our tour, we will experience several
highlighted laboratory areas, including the
Hydraulics, Chemistry, Human Factors, and

BALTIMORE/ WASHINGTON AIRPORT



Baltimore/Washington International Airport (BWI), located in Baltimore, MD, is the largest and busiest airport in the DMV area, serving over 27 million passengers annually. The airport is named after Thurgood Marshall, a Baltimore native who was the first African American to serve on the Supreme Court of the United States.

PORT OF BALTIMORE



The Maryland Port Administration (MPA) oversees the Port of Baltimore City, one of the nation's busiest ports, with cargo, container, and cruise ships passing through daily. The Port of Baltimore has the deepest harbor in Maryland's Chesapeake Bay, allowing it to accommodate some of the world's largest container ships. The port is also one of Maryland's primary economic generators, and offers significant job opportunities for the region. Our tour of the terminal will cover information about the history of the Port, explain the Port's economic impact, and explore how cargo is generally handled.

U.S. CAPITOL BUILDING

WIS

The Capitol Building is the home of the United States Congress. The famous dome structure is a prominent feature on the National Mall; it holds legislative chambers and offices, as well as historic artwork and sculptures commemorating the country's origins. Our tour will explore the historic Capitol grounds, showcasing key landmarks such as the Rotunda, Statuary Hall, and Crypt.
