




WTS International Vision:

WTS attracts, sustains, connects and advances women's careers to strengthen the transportation industry.






WTS International Guiding Principles


In 2023, WTS Atlanta awarded \$17,500 in scholarships. Your donation will help with the long-term sustainability of the Scholarship Fund.
