



North/South & West/East Regional Corridors:



- Tangerine Road: Shannon Road to SR 77
- Lambert Lane: Pusch View Lane to Rancho Sonora
- La Cañada Drive: Moore Road to South Corporate Limit
- First Ave: Tangerine Road to SR77
- La Cholla Blvd: Tangerine Road to South Corporate Limit
- Magee Road: Northern to SR77
- All built to their ultimate 4-lane cross section
- Represent 94% N/S & W/E regional corridors in Oro Valley .
 - 6% capacity improvements remaining



Present: Pavement Preservation Program

Roadway Network 430 Lane Miles

Local: 250 Lane Miles

• Collector: 79 Lane Miles

• Arterials: 101 Lane Miles

• Treat per year: 50 – 100 lane miles

• Annual Investment: Over \$2M - \$2.5M


- La Cañada Drive: Tangerine Road to Moore Road
- Lambert Lane: La Cholla Blvd to West Corporate Limit
- Rancho Vistoso Blvd: Vistoso Highland to Honey Bee Bridge
- First Ave: CDO Bridge to SR77
- La Cañada / Tangerine Road Intersection





Present: Naranja Drive Multi-Use Path

- 10-ft wide multi-use path on north side of Naranja From La Cañada Drive to First Avenue
- RTA and RTAG funded
- ADOT LPA Design & Construction
- Designer: EPS Group
- Open House February 13, 2024
- Start Construction late 2024 or early 2025





Present: Tangerine Road – Flashing Yellow Arrows

La Cañada Drive/Tangerine Road Intersection &

First Avenue/Tangerine Road Intersection

- Administered by ADOT
 - HSIP Funded
- Designer: Kimley Horn
- Design Kick-Off Meeting January 2024
- Anticipate starting construction early 2025

Grand Opening in May 2024
