

<u>Leadership Graduate or Undergraduate Scholarship</u> WTS Southwest Idaho Chapter

Part of the WTS goal of fostering the development of women in the transportation field can be realized by encouraging bright new professionals to undertake careers in the area of transportation. The WTS Leadership Scholarship is awarded to women pursuing graduate or undergraduate studies in transportation or a related field who demonstrate leadership skills, ability, and interest.

The purpose of the WTS Leadership Scholarship is to motivate and reward women who demonstrate leadership in the transportation industry. The leadership, skills, and perspectives of women are essential to assure that the transportation systems of the future respond to the needs of all. Leadership does not just happen. Leaders personally invest and risk much. They must take on struggles that many would avoid and persevere to reach successful outcomes. These qualities should receive special attention in the selection of the award winner. The SW Idaho WTS Chapter will award one **\$3,000** for the WTS Leadership Scholarship. The winner of the WTS SW Idaho Chapter scholarship will advance to the national scholarship competition with an opportunity to receive an additional **\$5,000** scholarship.

The minimum criteria for selection are:

- a. GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- b. Currently enrolled in an undergraduate or graduate degree program in a transportation-related field, such as transportation engineering, planning, finance, or logistics.
- c. Plans to pursue a career in a transportation-related field.

Applications must be submitted to the WTS SW Idaho Chapter as one **PDF** document. Scholarships are competitive and based on the applicant's specific transportation goals, academic record, and transportation-related activities or job skills. WTS SW Idaho Chapter scholarships will be awarded in December and scholarship recipients will be honored at our annual WTS Gala. Recipient's attendance at this reception is strongly encouraged as an opportunity to meet transportation leaders and professionals in Southwest Idaho.
