- c. Currently enrolled in a degree program in a transportation-related field at a community or trade college
- d. Plans to pursue a career in a transportation-related field

The scholarships are competitive and based on the applicant's specific transportation study goals, academic records and transportation-related activities or job skills. Minority candidates are encouraged to apply.
