The Undergraduate Scholarship minimum criteria for selection are as follows:

- b. GPA of 3.0 or higher
- c. Currently enrolled in a transportation-related undergraduate degree program, such as transportation engineering, construction management, planning, finance or logistics
- d. Plans to pursue a career in a transportation-related field

The scholarships are competitive and based on the applicant's specific transportation study goals, academic records and transportation-related activities or job skills. Minority candidates are encouraged to apply.
