

# Undergraduate Leadership Scholarship Program

WTS fosters the development of women in the transportation industry by encouraging bright new professionals to undertake careers in the area of transportation. One way it does this is by awarding the Frankee Hellinger Scholarship to women pursuing undergraduate studies in transportation or a related field who demonstrate leadership skills, ability, and interest.

The Undergraduate Scholarship minimum criteria for selection are as follows:

- a. Open to women
- b. GPA of 3.0 or higher
- c. Currently enrolled in a transportation-related undergraduate degree program, such as transportation engineering, construction management, planning, finance, or logistics
- d. Plans to pursue a career in a transportation-related field
- e. Applicants for the leadership scholarship must specifically address the issue of leadership in their personal statement

The scholarships are competitive and based on the applicant's specific transportation study goals, academic records, and transportation-related activities or job skills. Minority candidates are encouraged to apply.

Please send it along with all the application materials.
- VI. **Proof of Enrollment**: Attach a copy of your tuition receipt or current registration card.
- VII. Official School Transcript: An official school transcript must be submitted by your school directly to the Scholarship Chair or Co-chair. Copies or original transcripts sent from students will not be accepted. An electronic official transcript from your school is highly desirable. If your school is not able to send an electronic transcript, a version sent via mail will be accepted.
