## Scholarship Eligibility

The WTS Southwest Ontario Chapter Scholarship is open to any student who meets the following criteria:

- Registered full-time at a post-secondary institution in the Kitchener / Waterloo / Guelph, London, Windsor, Hamilton areas.
- Pursuing a degree or diploma which will lead to a career focused on transportation
- Demonstrates interest in promoting the advancement of gender diversity within the transportation industry.
- Demonstrates strong academic performance
- Registered as a WTS Student Member (membership is free for students)
- *Past WTS Toronto Area Chapter Scholarship award recipients are not eligible for the WTS Southwest Ontario Scholarship.*
