



## 2025 Ava Doner Memorial Scholarship for Undergraduates

WTS Los Angeles established this scholarship in 2000 to encourage women to pursue career paths in transportation. The scholarship is awarded to women pursuing undergraduate studies in transportation, planning, or a related field. WTS-LA will award Ava Doner Memorial Scholarship winners at our **November 06, 2025**, scholarships awards gala and dinner in downtown Los Angeles. Scholarship Winners' attendance is highly encouraged. Award amounts will vary and typically range between **\$1,500 and \$5,000**, depending on available funding. Applicants are also eligible for sponsored WTS-LA scholarships. Students of underrepresented communities are strongly encouraged to apply. **The application deadline is June 18, 2025.**

Applicants must meet the following criteria to be considered for the scholarship:

- Open to women and non-binary individuals.
- A minimum **GPA of 3.0**.
- Current enrollment in an **undergraduate-level program** in a transportation-related field, such as transportation planning, engineering, geospatial, security planning, business management, finance, or logistics, with an emphasis on public policy or innovation.
- A demonstrated commitment to pursuing a **career in the transportation industry**, specifically within the **Los Angeles County transportation sector and system**. This includes, but is not limited to, all modes of transportation of people, vehicles, and goods; roles in the public or private sector; and disciplines such as planning, engineering, construction, project or construction management, administration, public relations, and operations.
- Evidence of an active interest in addressing **transportation-related issues or challenges**.
- Submission of a **personal statement (500 words or less)** that outlines the applicant's interest in transportation, relevant academic or professional experiences, and how receiving this scholarship will support their ability to contribute meaningfully to the field.

NOTE: Previous winners of **this scholarship level** are not eligible to apply.

### Submission Instructions:

- **Format:** Submit your application and all required documents as a **SINGLE, merged PDF file**.

### Required Documents (in the following order):

1. **Completed Application Form**
2. **Proof of Current Enrollment**  
(e.g., enrollment verification letter, class schedule)
3. **Academic Transcript**  
(Unofficial copy is OK; must show your full name and institution name)
4. **One (1) Letter of Recommendation**  
(Academic or professional references preferred; must be signed [E-signature is OK.]

### Important Notes:

- **File Naming:** Name your PDF file as: ScholarshipName\_YourFullName.pdf  
(Example: UndergraduateScholarship\_JohannaClark.pdf)
- **Deadline:** All materials must be submitted by **June 18, 2025**. Late submissions will not be accepted.
- **Recommendation Letter:** If your recommender prefers to send the letter directly, they must email it to [Scholarships@wtsla.org](mailto:Scholarships@wtsla.org) with your full name and the scholarship name in the subject line.
