



2025 Skilled Trades in support of Pre-Apprentices and Apprentices Scholarship Application

Aligned with WTS's mission to attract, sustain, connect, and advance women's careers to strengthen the transportation industry, WTS Los Angeles has established this scholarship in 2024 to encourage women who are pursuing a career as a skilled trades worker in construction and/or transportation maintenance. Transportation-related infrastructure - planned or already in construction and/or transportation maintenance - offers tremendous job opportunities to women. WTS-LA offers this scholarship opportunity to support women with overcoming barriers to participation in the construction trades, such as access to quality childcare, transportation, mentorship, training and other support services. WTS-LA will distribute a scholarship to a pre-apprentice in an established apprenticeship readiness training program and/or an apprentice in a State-approved apprenticeship program. We will distribute the scholarships at our **November 06, 2025**, Scholarships and Awards Gala dinner in downtown Los Angeles. Scholarship Winners' attendance is highly encouraged. Award amounts will vary and typically range between **\$1,500 and \$5,000**, depending on available funding. Applicants are also eligible for sponsored WTS-LA scholarships. Students of underrepresented communities are strongly encouraged to apply. **The application deadline has been extended to July 11, 2025.**

Applicants must meet the following criteria to be considered for the scholarship:

- Open to women and non-binary individuals.
- Current enrollment in a **State-approved Pre-apprentice or Trade Apprenticeship program.**
- A demonstrated commitment to pursuing a **career in the transportation industry**, specifically within the **Los Angeles County transportation sector and system.** This includes, but is not limited to, all modes of transportation of people, vehicles, and goods; roles in the public or private sector; and disciplines such as planning, engineering, construction, project or construction management, administration, public relations, and operations.
- Evidence of an active interest in addressing **transportation-related issues or challenges.**
- Submission of a **personal statement (500 words or less)** that outlines the applicant's interest in transportation, relevant academic or professional experiences, and how receiving this scholarship will support their ability to contribute meaningfully to the field.

NOTE: Previous winners of **this scholarship level** are not eligible to apply.

4. **Attendance Records (Preferred, not required)**

- **Deadline:** All materials must be submitted by **June 18, 2025**. Late submissions will not be accepted.

The statement must not exceed 500 words. Please write in the space provided below.
