# RTA Next: Key Highlights

As an industry leader, always be prepared to answer RTA Next questions to your immediate community.

- 1. Think of the RTA as a builder, not a fixer
- RTANEXT
  Investing in transportation to meet your needs
- 2.RTA funds leverage other funds (federal, state grants)
- 3.48,000 additional jobs, \$2.9B revenue over baseline
- 4.**\$11.9B in economic benefits** new jobs, new tax revenue, etc.
- 5. Without RTA Next, loss of 60% of regional funding
- 6. Good roadways make Tucson **more competitive** for site selectors
