

WTS - Maine Chapter Undergraduate Scholarship

WTS fosters the development of women in the transportation field by encouraging women to undertake careers in the area of transportation. One way the Chapter does this is by offering the WTS – Maine Chapter Undergraduate Scholarship to women pursuing undergraduate studies in transportation or a related field.

WTS – Maine Chapter works to make a difference in our communities and hopes that this scholarship will encourage highly motivated women to pursue a career in transportation. The scholarship is open to women who are enrolled at a community college, technical/trade school, or university and are pursuing two-year or four-year degrees and planning a career in transportation.

The WTS – Maine Chapter is offering up to three Undergraduate Scholarships in the amount of \$1,500 to \$3,000. The minimum criteria for selection are:

- a. GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- b. Currently enrolled in an undergraduate two-year or four-year degree program in the State of Maine. Applicants should be in transportation related fields (such as transportation engineering, urban planning, finance, or logistics).
- c. Plans to pursue a career in a transportation-related field.

Applicants must be Maine residents. Applications must be submitted to the WTS – Maine Chapter as typed documents. Scholarships are competitive and based on the applicant's specific transportation goals, academic record, and transportation-related activities or job skills.

- **VI. Proof of Enrollment**: Attach a copy of your tuition receipt or current registration card.
