Barri recently reflected on her first semester at North Carolina A&T. She shared that the most exciting part of starting college has been meeting such amazing and diverse people. She has also enjoyed engaging with her studies in a deeper, more meaningful way—an experience that has made everything feel more real and purposeful.

In starting school, she has learned a lot about herself. "One of the biggest things I've learned about myself since starting college is that I am very willing to grow. College has taught me early on how to accept no's, missed opportunities, and setbacks. There are times when things do not go the way you expect, and that can be hard at first. But I've learned that life keeps moving forward whether you get the opportunity or not. Instead of letting those moments stop me, I use them as motivation to keep pushing. I now see myself as someone who does not fall back when things get tough but finds a way to grow through it."

In her first semester, Barri attended the National Society of Black Engineers regional conference and received the McDonald's Golden Arches of Positivity-Thurgood Marshall Scholarship.
