Through a dynamic Women in Transportation panel moderated by Assemblywoman Dr. Carmen Morales, panelists shared their personal career journeys, lessons learned navigating change, and insights into building successful and fulfilling careers within the transportation industry. The Bridges That Connect Us – Investing in the Future of the Delaware River Crossings hosting by the WTS New Jersey Advisory Council

On October 9, 2025, transportation professionals gathered aboard The Moshulu in Philadelphia for a joint networking breakfast hosted by the WTS New Jersey and Philadelphia Chapters. Set against the backdrop of the Delaware River, the event convened engineers, planners, and public agency leaders for an engaging discussion on the planning, design, and long-term maintenance strategies that sustain the region's critical bridge infrastructure.

Attendees gained valuable insight from two distinguished leaders whose organizations play a vital role in keeping the region connected. Kevin Skeels, PE, Chief Engineer of the Delaware River Joint Toll Bridge Commission (DRJTBC), and Mike Venuto, PE, PLS, Chief Engineer of the Delaware River Port Authority (DRPA), shared updates on upcoming bridge improvement projects and long-term investment programs on both sides of the river, highlighting the scale and complexity of managing these essential crossings.

The discussion, expertly moderated by Ariella Maron, Executive Director of the Delaware Valley Regional Planning Commission (DVRPC), underscored how sustained infrastructure investment strengthens regional mobility, safety, and economic vitality. Through collaboration and forward-thinking planning, the conversation reinforced the critical role bridges play in shaping the future of transportation across the Delaware River region.
