Michelle Meaux, AICP, has 20 years of experience in regional transportation planning in the Austin region. She is the Long-Range Planning and Geographic Information Systems Manager for Transportation and Natural Resources at Travis County. Michelle's team is responsible for the County's long-range transportation plan, which is called the Transportation Blueprint; the County's Safe Streets and Roads for All Safety Action Plan; the Travis County Transit Development Plan; and other transportation planning efforts. She represents the County on several committees and was recently appointed to the Capital Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (CAMPO) Technical Advisory Committee.

Prior to joining Travis County in 2025, Michelle served as the Local Government Projects Coordinator at the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) Austin District, where she managed the District's Transportation Alternatives Program and guided local governments through the TxDOT project development process.

From 2013 to 2019, Michelle was the Regional Coordination Manager at the Capital Metropolitan Transportation Authority (CapMetro), where she was responsible for developing and implementing CapMetro's Service Expansion Policy and coordinating transit plans with jurisdictions outside the CapMetro service area. She also led the Office of Mobility Management, a partnership between CapMetro and the Capital Area Rural Transportation System that focused on connecting people with transportation providers in the region. Michelle also served as CapMetro's treasurer of the Transit Empowerment Fund from 2015 to 2019.

Michelle's focus on regional transportation planning started in 2006 at CAMPO, where she coordinated the Congestion Management Program, Linking Planning and NEPA, and the Regional Transit Coordination Committee. Michelle also supported the development of the Regional Transportation Plan and the Transportation Improvement Program during her time at CAMPO.
