

WTS Atlanta Chapter 2026 Program for Public Sector Emerging Professionals

The WTS Atlanta Chapter (WTS Atlanta) recognizes the importance of developing future leaders, growing our membership, and providing opportunities to individuals who may face barriers to join or actively participate in the organization. The **Program for Public Sector Emerging Professionals** is one such program that ensures the future success and growth of our Chapter. This Program will assist in the development of future leaders by providing four awards to potential WTS Atlanta members. Eligible applicants must work in a transportation-related career in the public sector and not be eligible to receive reimbursement from their employer for WTS membership expenses.

Selected participants of the **Program for Public Sector Emerging Professionals** will receive the following:

- Paid membership dues for one year.
- Paid attendance to all WTS Atlanta events (including the Annual Scholarships and Awards Luncheon).
- Advisor commitment from a WTS Atlanta Board member for one year, and

Through the course of their term, selected participants must agree to Chapter involvement and personal professional development by meeting the following requirements:

- Attend two or more Board meetings.
- Assume an active, responsible committee role or other position of responsibility in the Chapter and/or lead and complete a project identified by the Board for the WTS Atlanta Chapter.
- Author a newsletter article on her experiences with the program.
- Provide quarterly updates to the Board or Advisor showing progress with program requirements
- Meet with her WTS Atlanta Advisor three (3) or more times during the year, and
- Establish a set of goals for success in the Program (to be refined with the Advisor) to meet over the course of her term.

Applications must be submitted to the WTS Atlanta Chapter POC, Dania Aponte. A Selection Committee comprised of Board members will review applications and make recommendations to the full Board of Directors who will select participants based on a majority vote. The process is competitive and based on the applicant's specific goals for serving in the Chapter and description of how these goals will benefit her career as well as the WTS Atlanta Chapter. Incomplete applications will be rejected.

(4) Identify your goals for a successful year as a member of WTS Atlanta.
