One year after the Stonewall Uprising, the first Pride marches were held on June 28, 1970, in New York, Los Angeles, and Chicago. Since 1970, Pride has been celebrated every year in Chicago and has turned into a month-long celebration.



Here's some ways to celebrate Pride all month long in Chicago:

- **Go on a group bike ride!** Organizations like [Femmes + Thems Bike Chicago](#), [Dykes on Bikes](#), and [Windy City Cycling club](#) are all social bike rides that happen across the city.
- **Explore nature!** [Queer Chicago Outdoor](#) organizes group hikes, swims, and climbs in the Chicagoland area. [Feminist Bird Club Chicago](#) organizes bird walks across the city. Walk around the AIDS garden located on the Lakefront Trail near Belmont Harbor.
- **Attend Pride events!**
 - Sunday, June 29th 11:00 am – Chicago's Pride Parade
 - Saturday June 21st and Sunday June 22nd – Chicago Pride Fest in North Halsted
 - Saturday July 5th 11:00 am – Pride South Side at the DuSable Black History Museum
 - Celebrations across Chicago's suburbs, including Buffalo Grove, Park Ridge, Elgin, Downers Grove, Des Plaines, Aurora, Woodstock, Ottawa, Lake County, and more!
