WTS fosters the development of women in the transportation industry by encouraging bright new professionals to undertake careers in the area of transportation. One way it does this is by awarding the WTS Tampa Bay Harbor to Highway Scholarship to women pursuing undergraduate studies in transportation or a related field.

The Undergraduate Scholarship minimum criteria for selection are as follows:

- a. Open to women
- b. GPA of 3.0 or higher
- c. Currently enrolled or accepted in a transportation-related undergraduate degree program, such as transportation engineering, construction management, planning, finance or logistics
- d. Plans to pursue a career in a transportation-related field

The scholarships are competitive and based on the applicant's specific transportation study goals, academic records and transportation-related activities or job skills. Minority candidates are encouraged to apply.
